# 1. Preamble

Young, innovative companies with ambition and potential for growth are key for the economic and social development of the territories. Their contribution is not limited solely to generating wealth and employment, but also to creating knowledge and developing technology and solutions for new societal challenges and needs.

These young, innovative companies face great challenges related to product development, negotiations, and market access in their first stages. To face these challenges, the companies need not only specialised financing, but also expert guidance that will help them to develop their potential and improve their capability to attract investors and clients.

To that end, through "CaixaBank, CaixaBank, S.A., and its subsidiary Caixa Emprendedor XXI S.A.U.," we contribute to the development of young, innovative companies with high growth potential, providing them with financing and expert guidance in their first stages and in their later growth through DayOne, the CaixaBank service for tech companies and investors.

Furthermore, through the Start-up AwardsXXI, we identify, recognise, and provide guidance to recently created, innovative companies with high growth potential. The Start-up AwardsXXI aim to drive companies that have taken their first steps, allowing them to accelerate their growth process and global expansion.

This year we will be in our 17th edition of boosting entrepreneurship in Spain and Portugal. Since the awards were created in 2007, we have helped the 498 winning companies and we have given away more than 8,3 million euros in prizes. The Start-up AwardsXXI have also had the support of over 135 entities that have been joining the initiative as co-grantors, co-organisers, or collaborators, and more 300 businesspeople, investors, and representatives of companies linked to the enterprise that they participate annually in the 50 committees and juries that are celebrated across the Whole of Spain and in Portugal.

In this seventeenth edition of the Start-Up AwardsXXI Challenges Award, we seek to provide solutions for the main challenges to society in 2023 and the current economic environment. We have therefore created new categories of challenges, focusing on the challenges of the future and how technological companies are seeking solutions for those challenges here and now.



# 2. Start-up AwardsXXI. 2023 Call

The CaixaBank group, through CaixaBank SA (CaixaBank DayOne), announces the seventeenth edition of the Start-up AwardsXXI to identify, recognise, and provide guidance to recently created, innovative companies with high growth potential in Spain and Portugal.

The Start-up AwardsXXI are co-granted with the Ministry of Industry, Commerce, and Tourism through Empresa Nacional de Innovación S.M.E., S.A. (ENISA) in Spain and Banco BPI in Portugal and have the support of leading entities involved in the support of the development of innovative companies.

The Start-up AwardsXXI seek to identify young, innovative companies which, after having had some initial successful results, have an ambitious growth plan ahead of themselves and need resources to carry out their plan.

Participating companies may choose from among the following awards:

- Regional Awards to companies with high impact in their territory. All companies in a territory may opt for this award regardless of their sector. This award is co-granted in Spain with the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Tourism and through ENISA in Spain and with Banco BPI in Portugal.
- Future Challenge Award exclusively intended for companies that provide solutions to the different challenges posed in each of the categories. Upon entry, participants will choose which challenge they want to take part in and all companies submitting an entry for said challenge will have a chance to win, regardless of the region they are in. These 6 categories include two challenges each and are related to the sectors that most represent and are most sensitive to the current reality of society and the economy...

#### International accompaniment

As well as a cash prize, the winning companies in the regional stage (19 companies) and the winners of the 12 challenges will benefit from a support programme in one of the main worldwide innovation ecosystems.

#### second prizes

Two special second prizes will also be awarded amounting to €9,000 each: the Sustainability award for the company with the greatest positive influence on society and the DeepTech award for the most groundbreaking technological innovation.

The Start-UpXXI Awards rely on the support of different entities in the sphere of innovation. If any awards other than those published are presented, information on said awards will be provided on the award website (www.emprendedorxxi.es) and social channels (X and LinkedIn).



#### **Investors Day EmprendeXXI**

The regional winners and the finalists and winners of the challenges will take part in the Start-UpXXI Investors Day. This conference aims to bring together the more than 30 winning start-ups of the Start-UpXXI awards with the main investors in the sector and corporates with an interest in innovation. Several events are also planned for 2023 and 2024.

#### **DayOne Open Innovation Program**

The Start-up AwardsXXI, via CaixaBank DayOne, will soon launch the third edition of the initiative "DayOne Open Innovation Program" in which will be able to participate the companies that they have presented its candidacy in this edition of the Start-up AwardsXXI.

The DayOne Open Innovation Program, is an initiative that expects to bring closer the entrepreneurial ecosystem to the different business areas of the company and jointly develop innovative projects. For this, the startups will be able to present its solutions to challenges in different fields, linked to the 6 challenges of the 17th edition of Start-up AwardsXXI.

The conditions specific to this initiative, as well as the bases of share, dates, challenges, etc will be communicated through publication in the service channels specific to Start-up AwardsXXI and CaixaBank dayOne.

The organisation reserves the right of expanding the resource in kind of the prizes, through agreements with collaborative third parties. In this case will learn more via the website and social networks of the Start-up AwardsXXI.



# 3. Participation requirements

In order to present an application for the Start-up AwardsXXI, candidate companies must meet the following requirements:

- Be companies **incorporated as a profit-seeking legal entity** (S.A., S.L., Employee-owned companies, Cooperatives, Business Partnerships) and have a tax residence in Spain or Portugal.
- Have **started their activity subsequent to 01 January 2019.** (High in model 036 of the Treasury).
- The founding members must lead the company, hold a majority shareholder percentage and work principally in the company, as well as have experience in the sector and the aim to create teams. (The participation requirement of more than 50% does not apply to technology transfer initiatives derived from Universities and research centers, as long as the entrepreneurial team is made up of technical and business profiles)
- The Regional Award is intended for **innovative technological enterprises** in any sector of activity, broken down by territory.
- The Start-UpXXI Awards Challenges Award is intended for the companies with the greatest potential to **take on the challenges posed** in each of the proposed areas. Upon entry, participants will choose which challenge they wish to take part in from a total of 12:

The call is intended for **technological and digital companies**, with a high growth potential and **scalable and innovative business models**, with innovation understood in a broad sense (product, processes, business model, etc.

The following are explicitly excluded:

- self-employed individuals or freelancers
- companies considered "large companies" according to the European Commission, i.e., companies that have more than 250 employees and have more than 50 million Euro in annual revenue or whose annual balance sheet exceeds 43 million Euro, or companies that have more than 25% of their capital held by one or more companies considered "large" according to the definition above.

Companies that have been awarded in previous editions may not compete for the same award, but they can apply for and compete in other categories and for the second prizes.



# 4. Candidate application

Candidates may only apply for the Awards exclusively online through the website of the Start-up AwardsXXI, which will have a link to access the candidate registration platform. The website for the Awards is: <a href="http://www.emprendedorxxi.es/en/">http://www.emprendedorxxi.es/en/</a>.

More specifically, candidates must:

- Fill in the application form, and
- Attach the documentation that accredits that the application meets the terms and conditions, the rest of the mandatory information, as well as the optional information that may be considered suitable.

The candidate application period begins on Thursday, **26 October**, **26**, **2023 at 09:00 a.m.** and ends on Monday **December**, **12**, **2023 at 18:00 p.m.** (all times are listed in GMT+1).

The organisation reserves the right to change the opening and closing dates of the candidate application period. If this occurs, it will be reported on the Start-up Awards XXI website and its social networks.

# 5. Evaluation criteria


The following criteria will be taken into account when evaluating candidates:

- Team: Commitment, dedication, and risk assumed by the entrepreneurial team; suitability of the team's experience/training to the needs of the business; composition of the team and capacity to attract talent; motivation; existence of Boards of Directors and the profile of the experts, the founding teams shareholder percentage in the company, etc.
- **Business model**: Value chain and monetisation of the business model; competition analysis; capacity to attract customers; commercial and marketing plan; potential and capacity for globalisation; capacity or probability of having the necessary resources to implement the business plan; internal and historical coherence of financial projections, etc.
- **Ambition**: Size and growth projection of the accessible market; scalability; existing and expected competition; concentration of customers; ambition and strength of sales projections; expected gross margin; job creation, etc.
- **Innovation**: Level of innovation of the product or service; suitable analysis of customer needs; competitive advantages and barriers to entry; positioning with respect to competition, suitability of its proposed value to the transformation and impact in its sector, etc.
- **Historic**: Revenue and/or financing achieved; results obtained with respect to the resources employed, etc.

For the Awards to the best company in its region, in addition to the criteria above, the company's link to and impact on the region will be evaluated. For the Start-up AwardsXXI Challenges, will be considered also the lace of the proposal with the challenge, the state of development of the project and the potential of impact in the challenge posed.



# 6. Selection process

#### Evaluating and scoring candidates

- 1. Eligibility analysis. The candidates are reviewed once the application period closes. This review centres on confirming that the candidates match the profile of the target company for the Awards and that they meet the participation requirements detailed in these terms and conditions, especially with regards to its innovative component. Candidates that do not match the participation requirements are discarded from the process.
- 2. Scoring. Applications are reviewed and scored based on the information provided in the application form and the attached documentation. The applications are evaluated remotely by independent evaluators who score them based on standardised evaluation tables that include more than 20 criteria.



**3. Creating the rankings**. Once the initial evaluation process is finished, the candidates are sorted by score and different rankings are generated by territory or sector, which are then sent to the corresponding selection bodies.

#### **Selection** process for regional awards

- 4. The Technical Committees The Technical Committees are made up of representatives of the co-grantors of the Start-UpXXI Awards, the organising entities, and experts in the entrepreneurial ecosystem (successful entrepreneurs, business angels, venture capitalists). The Technical Committee analyses the top-ranking candidacies submitted and the scores given, and selects which companies will present their projects to the regional Jury. Wherever possible, the Technical Committee may request the presentation and defence of the application by the competing company in an online session and, in some cases, they may organise pitch preparation sessions for the finalists. Attendance to these sessions, if organised, is mandatory to remain in the process.
- 5. Juries and award ceremonies: Juries designate the winning company from each community. Regional Juries are formed by members representing the co-grantors, institutional representatives, investors, prestigious entrepreneurs, successful entrepreneurs, and former winners of the Start-up AwardsXXI. The jury is presided over by CaixaBank and the co-grantor. The Jury requires that the competing company present and defend the candidate. Furthermore, they may organise pitch preparation sessions for the finalists. Attendance to these sessions, if organised, is mandatory to remain in the process. The Jury's decision cannot be appealed and will be made public during the Start-up AwardsXXI ceremony, which may take place that same day or on a later date. The Award ceremony will take place during the DayOne Innovation Summit assigned to the Autonomous Communities. All the participants that have been appointed finalists commit to attend. The award ceremonies will be celebrated in person, in the first quarter of 2024 and the exact dates will be published on the website (http://www.emprendedorxxi.es/en/).

#### Selection process for Start-up AwardsXXI Challenges

- 6. Evaluation Commission: Evaluation Commission: The Evaluation Commission is composed of representatives of the granting entities, specialists in evaluating companies, and departments of CaixaBank which are ambassadors for the Start-UpXXI Awards. For each of the challenges, it selects which companies will be put forward to each Start-UpXXI Awards Challenges Award Technical Committee/Jury
- 7. Technical Committees Jury of the Challenges: The proposed Challenge Technical Committees/Juries are composed of leading professionals in the industry and sector, specialist investors, and institutional representatives. The Technical Committees/Juries will convene in May 2024 and will select the winning company and a runner-up for each challenge, which will then go on the final judging stage. The companies will present their candidacy before the Committee/Jury in a pitch format plus a round of questions. The decision of the Committee/Jury may not be appealed and will be announced during the Award ceremony.

Prior to the Jury-Committees, training and networking sessions will be organized with members of the ecosystem for the finalists. Failure to attend the Committee-Jury or the previous preparation sessions will lead to exclusion from the selection process



8. Award Ceremony: The award ceremony for the 6 challenge awards is planned for the month of May 2024 within the scope of the DayOne Innovation Summit Challenges XXI – place and date to be confirmed. During the ceremony the jury will convene for the final challenge stage and will be composed of managers from the CaixaBank departments that are involved in the Awards, as well as the co-grantors..

#### General aspects of the selection process

The organisation reserves the right to modify any date for the committees, juries, or awards ceremonies included in these terms and conditions, as well as to adjust the procedure in the selection process if deemed necessary. If this occurs, it will be reported on the Awards website (<a href="http://www.emprendedorxxi.es/en/">http://www.emprendedorxxi.es/en/</a>) and by email to the organising and collaborating entities.

In the event that the quality of the candidacies is not considered sufficient, the organisation may modify the number of candidacies that pass a phase or which move forward to the corresponding committees and juries, or it may declare the award forfeit.

The travel and accommodation costs of the companies that are called before the Committees and Jury for the Start-up Awards XXI Challenges are borne by the organisation (1 representative per company).

# 7. Awards

Through the Start-up Awards XXI, the organisers and joint prize givers wish to contribute decisively to promoting companies. Therefore, apart from financial contributions, the awards offer business development programmes and actions to increase the companies' visibility before key partners for their future.

The winning companies, at the time of accepting the awards, will commit to attend and carry out the accompanying programs. The economic endowment to be delivered to the winning companies may be deferred or reduced depending on attendance at the aforementioned programs and their associated cost.

All participating companies may choose from among the following awards:

# Regional Awards to companies with high impact in their territory

The 17 winning companies in Spain (1 winning company in each community) and the 2 winning companies in Portugal (1 winning company in each region) will be recognised as the companies with high growth potential in their region and will receive



- A financial contribution of €6,000 1.
- Access to an international development programme.
- Participation in the Investors Day EmprendedorXXI and possibility of participating in the DayOne
  Open Innovation Program
- Access to the DayOne AlumniXXI community with the winners of previous editions

# Start-up AwardsXXI Challenges: To companies with the greatest potential to solve the challenges posed

The 12 winning companies of the categories (6 categories with 2 challenges each: 1 winning company for each challenge) will be recognised as the company that has presented the best solution to the challenge posed and will receive a cash prize2:

€12,000 for the winner of each challenge:

#### **FUTURE PLANET**

We are looking for the best solutions to help preserve the planet and its natural resources, and enable sustainable farming.

Potential sectors: cleantech, recycling, energy, sustainability, agrotech, sustainable agriculture, procurement, biotech, etc.

This category involves two challenges:

#### **AgroBank**

Projects that transform the agrifood industry via sustainable husbandry and farming, incorporating technological innovation in production processes.

#### imagin

Projects focusing on leaving future generations with a better planet with solutions based on achieving a lifestyle in which natural resources are handled with care.

#### **FUTURE WELLBEING**

We are looking for projects focusing on civic wellbeing and disease prevention, paving the way for a full and healthy life.

Potential sectors: e-health, life sciences, the over 65s, impact, VR and AR

This category involves two challenges:

#### **VidaCaixa**

Solutions in the field of therapeutics, diagnoses, development of medical technologies, and e-health. We are looking for projects that apply technology to medicine to help improve the quality of health, patient access and disease prevention.

#### CaixaBank Seniors

Solutions focusing on the wellbeing of our elderly (silver economy) in all aspects of their everyday life to ensure active ageing, enjoyment of leisure time, and a long and healthy life thanks to technology.



#### **FUTURE TALENT**

We are looking for companies that support the development of human talent and the work of the future, understanding that we are living in a world of constant evolution and technological transformation, which implies very positive changes in society but also challenges for current and future generations.

Potential sectors: edtech, online platforms, MOOC, elearning, talent, SaaS

#### This category involves two challenges:

# International business development programme.

As well as the cash prize included in the award, the 19 winning companies of the regional award, the 12 winners of the challenges posed (2 companies for each category, 1 winner for each challenge) will have access to an international support programme.

The program will include an international stay in one of the main innovation hubs in the world. The program is scheduled to take place during the month of July 2024.

## International support and second prize in innovation

The Start-up AwardsXXI relies on the support of different international entities. The information on this topic will be reported on the awards website (<a href="https://www.emprendedorxxi.es/en/">www.emprendedorxxi.es/en/</a>) and its company channels.

The awards are supported by the Israeli Embassy in Spain and the Adjoint Ministry of Economy and the Agência Nacional da Inovação de Portugal..

To grant the second prizes in innovation, the evaluators will assess the value contribution and the disruptive capacity of the proposed innovation, with innovation being understood in a broad sense (technology, business model, processes, sales channel, etc.).

The promoters of the Start-up AwardsXXI will submit candidates that opt for the second prize to the entity that grants this prize, which will select and propose the winning company. The entity also reserves the right to declare the second prize forfeit. The entity granting the second prize may request additional information and perform interviews, whether in person or over the phone, with the candidate companies.

Two special second prizes will also be awarded amounting to €9,000 each: the Sustainability award for the most sustainable company following ESG criteria and the Deep Tech award for the most groundbreaking technological innovation.

# Investors Day EmprendeXXI

All of the companies winning awards in the 17<sup>th</sup> edition of the Start-up AwardsXXI will have access to the "Start-up AwardsXXI Investors Day" sessions where they will be able to network with the main investors and corporations with an interest in innovation. The dates and formats will be announced to the winning companies nearer the time.

# DayOne Open Innovation Programme

The EmprendeXXI Awards, through CaixaBank DayOne, will soon launch the "DayOne Open Innovation" program in order to select a company from each sector vertical in which a challenge is launched with which to carry out a pilot with a business area of the CaixaBank group.

The legal conditions to participate in this program will be published on the DayOne webşite



(www.dayonecaixabank.com) and Premios EmprendeXXI (www.emprendedorxxi.es). DayOne and Premios EmprendeXXI will inform the companies participating in the EmprendedorXXI Awards of the opening of this call, to which they may opt if they meet the participation requirements.

## Online training sessions for all candidates

In addition, just for presenting your candidacy for the Start-up AwardsXXI, the candidate companies will have access to online training sessions on some of the topics of greatest interest to entrepreneurs. These sessions will take place during the months of December 2023 to February 2024, dates pending final confirmation, and may consist of a webinar format, an online training course or others considered by the organization.

# DayOne AlumniXXI

The DayOne AlumniXXI community was born as a meeting point for the exchange of knowledge, ideas and experiences between the founders of the award-winning start-ups throughout the history of the Start-up AwardsXXI.

An initiative that combines a virtual community and face-to-face meetings that will help strengthen links and create synergies between the winners and the entrepreneurial and innovation ecosystem.

# 8. Confidentiality, Advertising and Delivery of Newsletters

The prizes are awarded by Caixa Emprendedor XXI S.A, co-awarded together with CaixaBank, S.A. together with the National Innovation Company S.M.E., S.A. (ENISA) of the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Tourism in Spain and Banco BPI in Portugal, and managed by CaixaBank SA through DayOne, its division for technology companies and their investors.

## **Confidentiality**

The confidentiality of the candidacies submitted will be guaranteed throughout the entire process. In any case, their general characteristics may be disclosed along with, in due time, the name of the winning projects, their logo, their activity and main achievements, as well as the members of the promoting team.
